There are 109 rooms and suites at Six Senses London, shaped by bold curves, inky blues, warm woods and a touch of mischief. Many open onto private terraces, perfect for morning light or late-night plotting. City out front, stillness behind.

At the top, The Whiteley Suite spans the full length of the building with two master bedrooms, marble bathrooms, a generous lounge and open kitchen. A full-length terrace pulls the outside in, with London laid out before you. It can also be connected to neighbouring suites to create a private floor.

DINING

At Six Senses London, food doesn't follow rules. It follows flavour, feeling and a little intuition. Rooted in our Eat With Six Senses ethos, everything is fresh, seasonal and thoughtfully sourced. We work with growers and makers who care, transforming honest ingredients into dishes you'll actually crave. Farm to table? Try farm to wow. At the heart of it all is Whiteley's Kitchen, Bar and Café.

The kitchen is where the alchemy happens. Led by Executive Chef Eliano Crespi and inspired by the rebellious spirit of William Whiteley, it brings seasonal produce to life with bold flavours and clever twists. No fuss. Just food worth talking about.

The bar moves with the day. Coffee and cold-pressed juice in the morning, low-intervention wines and small plates by afternoon, cocktails with a little attitude come nightfall.

The café spills into the courtyard with a mood that's easy and all-day. Coffee done right, homemade ice cream, pastries that go fast and sandwiches stacked with care.

SUSTAINABILITY

Sustainability at Six Senses London begins with the building itself. The redevelopment of The Whiteley, led by a Meyer Bergman-advised fund with Valouran and designed by Foster + Partners, preserves key original features of this Grade II listed landmark, including its façade, domed roof, central courtyard and grand staircase inspired by La Scala in Milan. The result is a heritage-led space built with intention and designed to last.

Six Senses has long been a leader in sustainable hospitality, and that legacy continues here. Operations are plastic-free, energy systems are efficient, and materials are chosen for their circular potential. Local sourcing is prioritised, impact is measured, and our Earth Lab creates space for guests and neighbours to learn, engage and take action. A dedicated Sustainability Director ensures we live up to our promises, every decision, every day.

SIX SENSES PLACE

A new rhythm for the city. This is a space to nourish and restore, to move with purpose, to gather, learn, and feel a sense of belonging.

HISTORY

Whiteleys takes its name from William Whiteley, the self-declared “Universal Provider” who opened a drapery shop in 1863 and set out to sell everything from a pin to an elephant. Legend has it, he did. A retail pioneer, he introduced the concept of personal shopping and created London’s first true department store, complete with a theatre, restaurants, art galleries and even a menagerie. It was frequented by royalty and famously featured in *My Fair Lady*, where Henry Higgins sends Eliza Doolittle to be outfitted as a proper lady. By the 1980s, Whiteleys had evolved into a shopping centre with a cinema and bowling alley before closing in 2018. Now, its spirit returns, reimagined for a city that never stands still.

RESIDENCES

The 14 Six Senses branded residences, available as one and two-bedroom homes, offer a refined approach to modern city living. As part of The Whiteley’s collection of 139 residences, which range from stylish one-bedroom apartments to expansive duplexes and grand penthouses, these select residences provide an exclusive opportunity to embrace the Six Senses lifestyle.

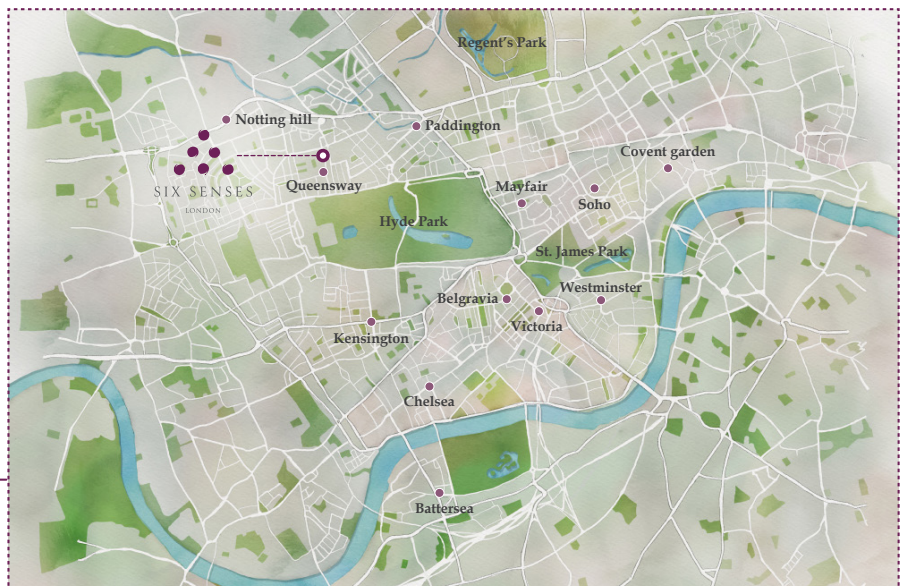


MEETINGS & EVENTS

Six Senses London is made for meaningful gatherings, from private dinners to small meetings and celebrations. A selection of intimate dining spaces and meeting rooms set the scene for connection, whether over business or something more personal. On the seventh floor, two suites offer refined, private settings for events. For something truly special, The Whiteley Suite spans 166 square metres with sweeping skyline views — perfect for receptions, brand showcases or boardroom meetings with a twist. For hands-on inspiration, the Alchemy Bar and Earth Lab bring guests together through immersive experiences that blend creativity, wellness and sustainability.

HOW TO GET THERE

Just steps from Bayswater and close to Kensington Gardens in Hyde Park, Westbourne Grove and Notting Hill, Six Senses London is well connected to the city and beyond. Heathrow International Airport is a 15-minute express train to Paddington Station, which is just a 5-minute taxi from the hotel. By car, Heathrow is 45 minutes to 1 hour 15 minutes away. Gatwick takes between 1 hour 15 minutes and 2 hours. Eurostar services at King's Cross St Pancras are around 25 minutes by taxi, and London City Airport is approximately 45 minutes away. Private transfers from all major terminals are available and must be booked in advance.
